Any additional books, supplements or charts to support your individual learning:

- Students are required to have their own sheets for all bodywork classes. 1 set of sheets is required for the Massage Technician Program and 2 sets are required for each of the other programs. Flannel sheets are recommended.
- With certain classes a teacher may incur their own costs of printing extra course materials. If this is the case, they may ask the students to help with these additional fees. These fees are to be paid to the teacher and not to BMC.

Student Loans:

Students may apply for loans through Sallie Mae Financial either by visiting the Administrative office, applying on line at www.slmeducationloans.com or by calling 1 (888) 2-SALLIE.

Interest Free Plans on Contract:

Payment in Full: Pay your program in full prior to your program start date and receive a cash credit toward any items in our Store!!

- HHP = \$200, MTH = \$100, MTR = \$50, MT = \$25

Interest-Free Monthly Payment Plan: For a limited time we will be offering an interest free monthly payment plan for students who wish to spread their tuition over the duration of their program. A minimum \$500 down payment is required upon enrollment.

Payment Plans with Interest:

Tuition spread over 1½ - 2 times the program length: Programs financed over 1-½ times the length of the contract will have a one-time, non-refundable 5% interest charge added to the total due. Programs financed over 2 times the length of the contract will have a one-time, non-refundable 10% interest charge added to the total due. In both situations a minimum \$500 down payment is required upon enrollment.

Student Tuition Recovery Fund (STRF)

You may also be eligible for STRF if you were a student that was unable to collect a court judgment rendered against the school for violation of the Private Postsecondary and Vocational Education Reform Act of 1989.

You must pay the state-imposed fee for the Student Tuition Recovery Fund (STRF) if all of the following applies to you:

1. You are a student, who is a California resident and prepays all or part of your tuition either by cash, guaranteed student loans, or personal loans, and
2. Your total charges are not paid by any third-party payer such as an employer, government program or other payer unless you have a separate agreement to repay the third-party.

You are not eligible for protection from the STRF and you are not required to pay the STRF fee if either of the following applies:

1. You are not a California resident.
2. Your total charges are paid by a third-party, such as an employer, government program or other payer, and you have no separate agreement to repay the third party.
